- ☐ General average of at least 1.75 or equivalent In the required course leading to the master's Degree applied for

### For Dissertation Grant

- ☐ Fifty years of age or less
- Approved dissertation proposal in any of the identified priority disciplines
- □ Completed the coursework and passed the comprehensive examination in either a program recognized as Center of Excellence, Center of Development or with an equivalent accreditation level or a graduate education program rated as a Very Good in the CHED Evaluation of Graduate Education in the Philippines (EGEP)
- ☐ General average of at least 1.75 or equivalent in the required course leading to the doctoral degree applied for
